As part of a continuing effort to fight against the spread of COVID, Uganda is still not allowing public gatherings of any kind. So, we do miss the weekly encouragement of the in-person church services, but our labor continues in the field.

At the beginning of the year, our pastor challenged us to hand out twenty tracts each week. As I go about my daily business, I give out various gospel tracts to people I see regularly. Later, I give them a personal letter, inviting them to receive Christ. Several have testified that they have already done so. Finally, I invite them to listen to Word of Life Radio where our services are broadcast live on Sunday and Wednesday.

Many people are tuning in to the radio services. On Sunday, after hearing the guest preacher's message, a woman called in and asked for prayer concerning anger. Many people are being helped by the broadcasts each week.

Some men have leveled an area near the radio station for the purpose of putting up a new tower and transmitter room. Missionary Keith Stensaas is on furlough raising money for it right now. It is exciting to think of how many people are hearing the gospel each day on the radio.

Other men in our church used the lockdown as an opportunity to translate the book of Ephesians from the King James Bible into Luganda. God's word is a sure comfort in troublesome times.

Two years have passed quickly and our son Daniel is now a graduate of Oklahoma Baptist College's Practical Christian Living course. His goal was to learn to be the best lay person he could be in order to help his pastor while working in the field of law enforcement. He is busy at a good summer job as he seeks God's direction in that regard.

Watching events unfold around the world in the last three months has been surreal to say the least. Many times I simply must take a breath and remember that this is a big election year in the United States. Anything can happen! We are certainly praying for you all and our nation at this time.
